## Policy 1 REQUIREMENTS TO BE A SANCTIONED SHOW

The Haflinger and Hitch Pony Championship Series(HHPCS) is for exhibitors of Draft type Haflingers and Draft Ponies that show their animals in the various driving classes and highlighting the 6-Horse Hitch competition. At the present time the 6-Horse Hitch and Ladies Cart class are the classes offered and sanctioned by the HHPCS

## **SECTION 1:**

Requirements to be a Haflinger and Hitch Pony Championships (HHPCS) Qualifying Show are as follows:

- 1. The show must offer a class or classes for 6-Horse Hitches
- 2. The show is encouraged but not required to also include a Ladies Cart class to their show
- 3. Each HHPCS "Series" sanctioned class must be an open class in which any member hitch has a chance to participate.
- 4. The show must pay a One Hundred (\$100.00) (US) dollar per year membership fee.
- 5. The show must have at least One Thousand (\$1,000.00) US Dollars in prize money for each six horse hitch class it would like to qualify, unless the show is held in Canada. If the show is held in Canada, the show must have at least One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Canadian dollars in prize money for each six horse hitch class it would like to qualify. All One Thousand (\$1,000.00) dollars must be paid out completely regardless of how many hitches are in the class.
- 6. The entire six horse hitch class must be placed from top to bottom
- 7. It is appreciated that you register your show as soon as possible so that a calendar of "Point Shows" can be prepared and exhibitors can include it in their plans. However, your fee must be received a minimum of 14 days prior to the date of your show.
- 8. Additional Classes: A Show may add (2) two additional six horse hitch classes for a maximum of (3) three classes for their show and (1) additional Ladies Cart class for a maximum of (2) classes for their show. All additional classes are subject to the above requirements. Notification of any additional classes must be provided to the HHPCS Executive Secretary at least 14 days prior to the start of the respective show.
- 9. Additional classes are required to pay an additional fee in the amount of \$100 for each additional class added. A show is limited to a maximum of (3) six horse hitch classes and (2) Ladies Cart classes total for their show.
  - If plans for your show progress and you find the funds to hold another class or add another judge, the Secretary must be notified a minimum of 14 days in advance of your show date. If this is not done, the class will not count for points
- 10. Within 30 days of the completion of the show the HHPCS Show Report Form supplied to you must be completed and returned to the HHPCS Executive Secretary as detailed on the form.

## Section 2:

The Show is encouraged to offer a Haflinger & Hitch Pony Championship Series Cart Class for Lady Drivers

- Each HHPCS sanctioned class must be an open class in which any HHPCS Lady Driver member
  has a chance to participate. The exception to this requirement is if the show has individual classes
  for Haflingers and Draft Ponies
- 2. The HHPCS Lady driver will receive the points, not the horse.
- 3. The entire Ladies Cart class must be placed from top to bottom.
- 4. There are no required premiums for the first Lady Cart Class
- 4a. If a second Lady Cart Class is offered, it must pay out One Thousand (\$1,000) US Dollars and an addition fee in the amount of \$100 is required
- 5. Within 30 days of the completion of the show the HHPCS Show Report Form supplied to you, listing the places of the top ten places must be completed and returned to the HHPCS Executive Secretary as detailed on the form.

## Section 3:

A show that has a Haflinger and Hitch Pony Championships class or classes that does not meet all the Requirements of the above listed, may be suspended for a period to be determined by the Board of Directors.
